Application for \$1,000.00 Scholarship

Each year the Southern California Chapter awards two (2) \$1,000.00 scholarships to deserving candidates. Scholarships shall be awarded to applicants who have been accepted as a student or is attending any accredited college, university, Trade School or an academy approved by the Scholarship Committee. Awards are limited to Southern California residents/students and one scholarship per school year in which it was given.

The Selection Committee reserves the right to request additional information as may be required to properly evaluate an application. Failure to provide the requested information will disqualify the applicant for consideration in that year.

Scholarship recipients shall be selected based upon a student's merit as determined by and at the sole discretion of the Committee, following the Committee's review of the student's scholastic achievement, character, personal and career goals, extracurricular activities, community service and references.

The scholarship award may be used for payment of tuition costs, room, board, books, instructional material or any other school fees. Payment will be made to the institution the student has been accepted or is attending.

All applications for scholarships must be received by the Southern California Chapter of NOBLE by January 31, 2008.

The chapter will announce and present the Scholarship Awards to the recipients at our 7th Annual Chapter Achiever's Award Banquet dinner, March 8, 2008 at the California African American Museum, Los Angeles. Winners will be notified after February 15, 2008.
